Each month in our newsletter we share with you, our donors and volunteers, news about the pantry and donations given. During November and December we receive an amazing number of donations, large and small. We showcase several of them here, but we don't always have a camera handy. To share with you the scope of the donations and to avoid missing anyone, we're sharing a fairly complete list of major donations we've gotten since Halloween. Counting the Turkey Bowl it amounts to more than 14,000 pounds of food and \$7,080.

- Oct. 27 - Kerry Cochran's Yoga in Park collected 35 pounds of food and \$150
- Oct. 31 - Abby's Mount students collected 3,736 pounds of food and \$20
- Nov. 5/12 - Wally Armour sent 100 turkeys from Wally Armour and six volunteers
- Nov. 9 - Turkey Bowl at Naborhood Inn raised \$6,257 and collected 157 pounds
- Nov. 13 - Washington Elementary School students collected about 2,200 pounds of food
- Nov. 15 - AHS National Honor Society collected 1,300 pounds and \$25
- Nov. 16 - Boy Scout and Cub Scout Troop 50 brought 1,150 pounds of food and \$20
- Nov. 19 - Family Video Store donated 15 turkeys
- Nov. 20 - MAC Trailer collected & donated from employees 3,255 pound of food & \$608
- Nov. 20 - Union Avenue UMC pre-school collected 131 pounds of food
- Nov. 20 - The Alliance Fraternal Order of Police donated 13 turkeys.
