McElroy Packaging of Orrville. On Thursday we received another 2,000 boxes that were unloaded by pantry volunteer Joe Cullum. Since we started we've received 14,100 12x12x10 inch boxes, which are also used for about 25 DoorDash deliveries every Tuesday.
